In a house, the kitchen is one of the most important places that you should check. Your things in the kitchen should work well so that you will be able to work on it the right way. Moreover, one of the things that are commonly improved is the kitchen sink.

They are used everyday so you must be very careful with it. However, even if it is already used up, there are still some people who do not want to replace their kitchen sink because it is too hard to do so.

It may need more efforts from you but when you know how you can properly do this you will know that it is actually easy enough to mount a sink properly on its right place.

First you should select a good Quality sink. One of the best choices for you would be the stainless steel sink. Since you are in a need for improvement, then you should carefully select the sink that you will buy.

With a stainless steel sink, you can be assured that it is of high quality. But you still have to check the size and depth of the sink so that you can buy the kind that would really fit your needs.

A lot of people agree that home improvement is in fact one of those continual tasks that we should keep on our list. As for any avid home improver, part of this list includes ensuring that you have the stainless steel sink that is in perfect condition.

Unlike other tasks, this case may actually call for extra labor or work. If you are still trying to figure out how to this by now, then follow these few, simple and fool-proof ways on how to install that new stainless steel sink in your kitchen.

Before you start worrying, let me assure you again that although it might sound complicated as it seems, all you need to do is follow these simple instructions. No need to fret, I will be making it as painless as possible. You'll be surprised that indeed, it's not rocket science to have that sink replaced.

What You'll Need



- ✓ Measuring tape
- ✓ Pencil
- ✓ Pipe
- ✓ Wrench
- ✓ Stainless steel double sink bowl unit
- ✓ Countertop cutting template, provided with sink
- ✓ Faucets that fit the sink unit
- ✓ T-screw clamp fasteners
- ✓ Flat-blade screwdriver
- ✓ Portable power saw
- ✓ 100 per cent silicone caulking
- ✓ Caulking gun
- ✓ Putty knife
- ✓ Utility knife

Installing a new stainless steel sink in your kitchen will make food preparation and cleanup amazingly easier. A double sink can be used for many purposes besides just washing vegetables and dishes. Follow the directions below to install a stainless steel double sink into your kitchen countertop.

Step 1: Install Connect the Faucet



Fit the faucet unit into the countertop and connect the taps to the hot and cold water pipes under the sink with a pipe wrench.

Step 2: Cut the Countertop Hole to fit the Sink Bowls



Measure the distance from the faucet to the countertop edge. Lay the cutting template for the countertop on the counter and outline it with a pencil, allowing a countertop edge of 2 inches at the front.

Cut out the countertop hole for the sink, following the template outline. Gently sand around the upper edge of the countertop hole to remove splinters and rough laminate pieces.

Step 3: Caulk the Sink Edge



Invert the sink unit over the countertop hole and apply a thick strip of silicone caulking all around the sink's lip edge. Press it down slightly with the putty knife to keep it in place when you flip the sink unit over.

Use silicone caulking instead of plumber's putty as the putty tends to dry out after just a few years.

Step 4: Press the Sink Unit Down into the Countertop



Turn the sink unit over and set it down into the countertop, pressing down heavily on the lip edge. A band of caulking should ooze out all the way around the sink edge, showing that a tight, waterproof seal has been formed.

Step 5: Fasten the Sink Edge to the Underside of the Countertop



Place four T-screw clamp fasteners at the four corners of the sink unit, with the slot head of the screw at the bottom. The clamp fastener grips the top and bottom of the countertop and the screw passes through the stainless steel of the sink itself.

Tighten the screws a little at a time each with the flat-head screwdriver until the clamps bite solidly into the countertop at top and bottom. The sink lip should be level all the way around when the screws are tightened correctly.

Step 6: Clean Off Excess Caulking with a Putty Knife



Wait for at least 2 hours for the caulking to harden. Carefully scrape off the excess hardened caulk from around the sink edge with the putty knife and utility knife.

If you try to clean off the caulking before it has set it will stick firmly to your tools, your hands, your clothes, and the countertop.

Step 7: Test the Taps and Plugs for Leaks



Put the drain plugs into the sinks and run the hot and cold water taps to fill them 1/3 full. Check for faucet leaks and that the drain plugs hold firmly.
